Therefore so great a Sacrament let us fall down and worship, and let the old law give way to a new rite, and let faith stand forward to make good the defects of sense. To the Father and the Son be praise and joy, health, honour and virtue and blessing, and to him proceeding from both be equal praise. Amen. – St Thomas Aquinas
