Some basic food stuffs are often in short supply: cartons of juice, instant rice, instant potato etc: ie, things that individuals and families can manage when resources are limited.

Toiletries are also in short supply (shampoo, soap, toothpaste, nappies, etc). During Lent, which starts in two week's time, the SVP will run a Lenten project to respond to this particular need.

Also we need your expertise. We do have parishioners with a good knowledge of Local Authority systems, housing law, legal skills and so on. Could you offer some time on a

voluntary basis for a few hours a week or when required? Let us, or one of our priests, know and we can forward names and contact details to the centre.
