The Holy See has given special permission for the feast of Blessed Oscar Romero on 24 March to be celebrated as a Memoria Mass in the Cathedral. The 12.30pm Mass that day will be celebrated by Bishop Pat Lynch and will be a sung Mass. All are welcome.

### **Joint Lutheran-Catholic Commemoration of the Reformation**

On Sunday 26 March 2017 at 3pm in St George's Cathedral, Archbishop Bernard Longley of Birmingham and Bishop Martin Lind, Bishop of the Lutheran Church in Great Britain, will jointly lead a Service of Common Prayer to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation.

The service will express thanksgiving for the one Gospel we share, repentance for the sadness of our divisions as Christians and commitment to joint witness to a wounded and broken world. Following the service there will be a Reception in the Amigo Hall. All are welcome.
