Like as the dew of Hermon which fell upon the hill of Sion. For there the Lord promis'd his blessing and life for evermore. Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost: As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. – Ephesians 4 & Psalm 133.*

### Translation of the motet at 11.30am Solemn Mass:

*O sacred banquet, wherein Christ is received; the memorial of his passion is renewed; the soul is filled with grace; and a pledge of future glory is given to us. Alleluia. – Magnificat antiphon for the feast of Corpus Christi.*
